

## SWARTHMORE IN SCHEDULE TO PLAY HOPKINS LACROSSE

After working on the subject for the last five weeks, Manager Makel, of the Johns Hopkins lacrosse team has announced his tentative schedule for the coming year. The schedule as far as it goes is as follows:

March 25, Columbia University; March 30, Navy; April 1, Alumni; April 8, pending; April 15, Harvard; April 22, pending; April 29, Swarthmore; May 6, Lehigh; May 13, Stevens.

With the exception of Swarthmore and Navy all the games will be played at Homewood. There is doubt about the Columbia game. Certain authorities at Hopkins contend that the game comes too early and will make the season too long. With Columbia on the schedule, the team will play two more games than it generally has, and it is a question whether certain players can stand the strain of the long season.

Manager Makel said that there are several teams that want to play Hopkins at Homewood on the two vacant dates—April 8 and 22. Of these he prefers to arrange games with Cornell and the Carlisle Indians. Both dates fit in nicely with the schedules of both the institutions. Cornell was anxious to play Hopkins last year, but the two managers were unable to reach an agreement as to terms. If manager Makel arranges a game with Cornell it will be the first time the Ithacans have played here in five years.

Lacrosse followers will also notice the position of Swarthmore on the schedule. Heretofore Hopkins has always played the quakers on the second Saturday in May. In the past it has always been the wind-up of the local collegiate season. The change is due to a recent decision of the Intercollegiate Lacrosse Association. That body decided that in the future the rotation system of schedules should be used. This means that Hopkins and Swarthmore will play on a different date every year.
