

# LOCAL ATHLETE DIES SUDDENLY

## Alex. Cosinuke, Jr., Ex- pires After Swarthmore Lacrosse Game

Nineteen-year-old Alexander Cosinuke, Jr., of 614 Wilson street, star player on the Swarthmore College lacrosse team, died suddenly early yesterday at Lexington, Va., following a three-day tour which his team had taken in the south.

Death was attributed by Dr. Reid White, physician at Washington and Lee University, to acute dilation of the heart.

Ten hours before he was taken by the fatal heart attack, Cosinuke had sparked the Swarthmore stickmen to a 4-1 victory over the Washington and Lee team. His teammates said he seemed perfectly well after the game and went with him to a dance at Virginia Military Institute for a short time.

Known to his many friends as Al, Cosinuke was popular at Swarth-
