

## STATE COLLEGE PLANS CLINICS

Plans for sports clinics in boxing and lacrosse as well as other sports to arouse interest among Delaware County scholastic athletes were discussed Monday at a meeting at the Penn State Center in Swarthmore.

On hand for the meeting were Charles Stoddard, director of extension physical education for the college, and Nick Thiel, lacrosse coach and head of the physical education program.

T. Stuart Marlow, recently appointed physical education head at the Center, met with them in an attempt to map out physical education plans for the Center and to tentatively schedule clinics for the Delaware County area.

It is understood that Leo Houck, Penn State boxing coach commissioned by the PIAA to conduct boxing clinics throughout the state, will be on hand to stage a clinic on the ring sport sometime in the fall. The clinic plan enables high school athletes to become better acquainted with a sport such as boxing, which is carried as a competitive sport by only two high schools in the state.
