

# Swarthmore Triumphs Over Oxford-Cambridge Team

## Driving Attack of Garnet Along With Strong Defense Humbles Britons in Lacrosse—Invaders' Goal Tender Injured But Remains in Game

Playing a surprisingly fast game, especially in the second half, the Swarthmore College lacrosse team yesterday afternoon defeated the combined Oxford-Cambridge team at Swarthmore by 11 goals to 8. This was the second defeat of the British team in three American starts.

A driving attack and a stonewall defense enabled the Garnet lacrosse team to administer defeat to the invaders. A crowd of more than a thousand spectators witnessed the game. Swarthmore led 5-4 at half-time.

After the Britons' crushing defeat of Penn it was not expected that Swarthmore stood much of a chance, but doubt was dispelled from the spectators after play had been on for a short time. Swarthmore took the offensive, and before nine minutes of the first half were over had tallied three times, while the Englishmen were shut out.

Captain Howard began the scoring for Swarthmore, putting in a long, unexpected shot, and this encouraged Palmer and Rickards to each add a point to the tally. It was then that Captain Melland, of the White and Blue team, led his men down the field, taking the ball on a clever back-hand pass, from the edge of the crease and tallying first for the Englishmen. Captain Howard scored again for the Garnet. But the Garnet attack was soon stopped when three English goals were hung up in a row. Just a few seconds before

half-time a goal by Blake gave the Little Quakers the lead at the end of the period.

In the second half Swarthmore scored three times again before the Englishmen got under way, and from then on the scoring alternated almost evenly until Swarthmore finally emerged the victors by three goals. Blake was individual high scorer for the Garnet with three tallies.

Goal tender Borden, of the Oxford-Cambridge team, suffered a bad cut over the nose in the first half but remained in the game.
