

LACROSSE TEAMS TO PLAY TO-MORROW

**Swarthmore College Players to Meet the
Englishmen on the Man-
heim Grounds.**

The Cambridge-Oxford lacrosse team will play its first game in this section to-morrow, June 23, on the Germantown cricket field at Manheim. It will line up against the crack team of Swarthmore College. Considering the showing it made against Toronto, June 3, Swarthmore has great hopes of winning from the Cambridge and Oxford Universities. Swarthmore is the strongest college team the Englishmen will meet in their stay in the United States. Swarthmore has only lost two games this season, those being Toronto, the score being 5 to 3, and Johns Hopkins, with the score 6 to 4.

The English team is made up of the best players of Oxford and Cambridge Universities, and they will no doubt put up a strong game. Captain Beans and Manager Taylor, of the Swarthmore team, intend to have all the regular team in the field, with the exception of Baldrige, whose place will be taken by Taylor, who was put out in the first of the season by a broken collar bone.
