

TIES THE MIDDIES.

Swarthmore Lacrosse Team Plays Navy to a Standstill in Fast Match.

A fiercely contested game of lacrosse at Annapolis, Md., between the twelves of the Naval Academy and Swarthmore resulted in a dead-heat, each team scoring six goals, though an extra period of ten minutes was played in order to give the opportunity of arriving at a decision. The Quakers appeared to be a little better skilled in teamwork than the Midshipmen, but the equality of the contest was maintained by the brilliant work of several of the Midshipmen, notably McDonnell, Hamilton, Gray and Davis.

Swarthmore scored first, the goal being thrown by Roberts, and secured a lead of two points in the first half, the score of the period being 4 to 2. The Midshipmen started the second period with a determination to catch up, and goals were thrown by McDonnell and Gray during the first ten minutes. Swarthmore scored next through an effort of P. Roberts, and just before time was called Gray again rallied and made the score even. The extra period was bitterly contested and there was some rather free use of the stick. Hamilton, the Navy's third defense, retiring with a bad cut over the eye. Goals were scored by P. Roberts for Swarthmore and McDonnell for the Navy, and though still further playing was suggested it was decided to let the score stand.
