

KORN URGES LACROSSE IN OLYMPIC PROGRAM

NEW YORK—Lou Korn, former Swarthmore football and lacrosse star, delivered a report before the Olympic Constitution Revision Committee meeting here, urging that lacrosse be made a regular event on the 1932 and all other Olympiads. Exhibition games were played during the 1928 Olympics at Amsterdam.

Korn was recently elected president of the National Collegiate Lacrosse Association.
