## Coach Sproul Lewis Has Garnet Lacrosse Team Out Daily

The Swarthmore lacrosse squad has been going through its paces on the front campus for the past two weeks under the watchful eye of Coach Sproul Lewis, of Chester, in preparation for the much-heralded encounter with the combined Oxford-Cambridge team, on Thursday, April 8. The British invaders are anxious to square accounts with the Little Quakers, who defeated them on their invasion three years ago by a 9-8 score.

Eleven of last year's men will join with Captain "Bill" Howard in presenting a veteran line-up. They will be augmented by a strong list of substitutes, many of whom are expected to displace their teammates before the close of the season. Koehnline, Ford, R.
