

NEW INDIAN STAR HAS FINE RECORD

Benny Haviland, who captained the 1929 Swarthmore College football team and who will play with the Indians this summer, has turned in a wonderful record as coach of the lacrosse team at Deerfield Academy, Deerfield, Mass., where he is also assistant coach of football and teaches mathematics.

While at Swarthmore, Haviland was a star at lacrosse and he introduced the game at Deerfield when he joined its faculty three years ago. The sport has become so popular there that it attracts more candidates than any other scheduled athletic activity. All over New England lacrosse has taken a firm hold, each year bringing more preparatory schools to adopt it.

In a season comprising ten games which just closed, Haviland saw his Deerfield boys score 91 goals to 27 for their opponents, winning eight games on a schedule that included Williams Fresh., Springfield Fresh., Exeter and Harvard Fresh. and losing only two games, each by a narrow margin. Andover won against them, 4 to 2, and Dartmouth Fresh. defeated them 10 to 9.
